The Milestones Ministry here at Myers Park Presbyterian Church is designed for children and youth during each year of their child and adolescent journey to mark an important moment in faith and life development. A milestone is:

- a stone set up beside a road to mark the distance in miles to a particular place.
- an action or event marking a significant change or stage in development.

In Children and Youth Ministries at Myers Park Presbyterian Church we believe it important to mark key moments in development. Those moments matter in our journey at significant turning points; and, those moments matter in our life together as we share foundational aspects of our faith and faith practices.

Each year, children and teens have an opportunity to participate in a specially designed Milestone ministry. For many of these workshops, parents are invited to come and participate to learn as well. We will be in touch by EMAIL to send further information for all spring events.

With each workshop, the child or teen collects symbols and tokens of each milestone along the way to place in the box. By the age of 18, each one will have a meaningful assemblage of their faith journey and learning.

Third Graders will complete their *Bible* Milestone on Sunday, March 6. Fifth Graders will complete their *Faith and Sexuality* Milestone on Sunday, February 27.
