Scripture and the Big Picture: Old Testament Wednesday Nights, 6:00-7:30 A-104

October 25 Timeline(s) of the Old Testament: We will review the whole story of the Old Testament, compare it to a timeline of world events. Then we will consider the timeline of how and when the Old Testament as we have it came together.

November 1 Torah (Law). We will explore how the various source documents come together to form what we have as the first five books of the Old Testament. We will also look at how the context of when they came together shapes how key stories are told, including Creation, Flood, Abraham, and Joseph, and the Exodus

November 8 Nevi'im (Prophets). We will explore the key messages of the former prophets and the latter prophets, including Samuel, Kings, Isaiah, and Jeremiah. We will also review key texts that make what we consider "history" to be prophetic writing.

November 15 Kethuvim (Writings). We will explore key texts of Poetry, the Five Scrolls, and other writings, including the Psalms, Ruth, and Daniel

November 22 NO CLASS—Thanksgiving Week

November 29 Intertestamental Period—We will explore the period leading up to the New Testament, including the Hasmonean Dynasty, the Book of Maccabees, and the historic realities of that time period.

When Did the Old Testament Come Together?



The Hebrew Bible/Tanak/Mikra

Contains Three Major Collections of Writings:

- Torah (Law)
- Nevi'im (Prophets)
- Ketuvim (Writings)

Torah/Pentateuch

Bereshith בְּרֵאשִׁית "In the beginning" Genesis

Shemot שָׁמֹות "The names of" Exodus

Vayikra וַיִּקְרָא "And He called" Leviticus

Bimidbar בְּמִדְבַּר "In the desert of" Numbers

Devarim דְּבָרִים "Things" or "Words" Deuteronomy

Four Source Documents for Torah

J-"Yahwist Source" Southern Kingdom

E- "Elohist Source" Northern Kingdom

P- "Priestly Source" Southern Kingdom

D- "Deuternomic Source" Southern Kingdom

When did these sources come about?

Yahwist (J source)

- o Oral tradition dating back to Exodus events begins to be formed during Solomon's reign, roughly 950 BC
- Stories of Samuel, Saul, David, & Solomon that will source 1 & 2 Samuel and 1 & 2 Kings also begin being brought together at the
 same time

Elohist (E source)

- o Oral traditions that inform E begin to take written form in early 8th century BC in the Northern Kingdom (790-780's BC)
- E blends with J during Southern Kingdom's 8th century, into the 7th -scholars speak of "JE"

Deuteronomic (D source)

 Early parts come together in Northern Kingdom alongside E, book of Deuteronomy is "discovered" during reign of King Josiah in the south in late 7th century, c. 620's BC

Priestly (P Source)

 Comes together in the 6th century during Babylonian Exile, informed by oral traditions around cultic practice going back to Temple and even Tabernacle times (Moses in the Wilderness)

Beginnings of 1 Kings take written form

When did Kethuvim come together?

Poetic Books

- Psalms—oral tradition extends from 10th century through 1,000 years
- Proverbs—begin being assembled during Solomon (10-21,) others in 8th to 7th BCE, 1-9
 likely post-exilic
- Job—Origins are VERY OLD, likely Persian, "Judaized" likely during exile and post-exilic as "counter-testimony"

Five Scrolls—likely exile and post-exilic

Other Books—likely much later, 300-100 BC

Glimpses Behind The Curtain

Genesis 26:4-5

⁴I will make your offspring as numerous as the stars of heaven, and will give to your offspring all these lands; and all the nations of the earth shall gain blessing for themselves through your offspring, ⁵because Abraham obeyed my voice and kept my charge, *my commandments, my statutes, and my laws*.'

Glimpses Behind the Curtain

2 Samuel 7:11b-16

Moreover, the LORD declares to you that the LORD will make you a house. ¹²When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. ¹³He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom for ever. ¹⁴I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. When he commits iniquity, I will punish him with a rod such as mortals use, with blows inflicted by human beings. ¹⁵But I will not take my steadfast love from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. ¹⁶Your house and your kingdom shall be made sure for ever before me; your throne shall be established for ever.

Glimpses Behind the Curtain

1 Kings 6:1-3, 38-7:2

In the four hundred and eightieth year after the Israelites came out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month of Ziv, which is the second month, he began to build the house of the LORD. ²The house that King Solomon built for the LORD was **sixty cubits long**, **twenty cubits wide**, **and thirty cubits high**. ³The vestibule in front of the nave of the house was twenty cubits wide, across the width of the house. Its depth was ten cubits in front of the house. ...³⁸In the eleventh year, in the month of Bul, which is the eighth month, the house was finished in all its parts, and according to all its specifications. **He was seven years in building it. Solomon was building his own house for thirteen years**, and he finished his entire house. He built the House of the Forest of the Lebanon **one hundred cubits long**, **fifty cubits wide**, and **thirty cubits high**, built on four rows of cedar pillars, with cedar beams on the pillars.

God's House v. Solomon's House

Cubit= 18 inches

God's House:

- Seven Years to Construct
- \circ 90 ft. x 30 ft. = 2,700 square feet

Solomon's House:

- 13 Years to Construct
- 150 ft. X 75 ft. = 11, 250 square feet
